**What is FUSE?** An artist development project for learning disabled people led by Club Soda, MOSS and SLIDE. **What is SoDaDa?**

**Run time:** 7pm-10pm

**Age guidance:** Ages 18+

**Technical requirements:** PA system for playback, lights (warm, cool, roaming, flashing), 4 mics, projector and screen

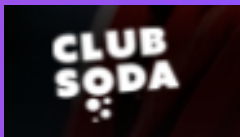
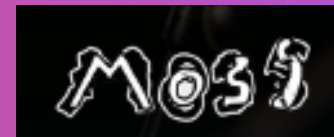
**Set up:** cabaret style with performance area

**Chill out space:** a quiet space near the main room for a sensory rest

**Get in:** 4- 6 hours

**Fee for London event: £1,500**

**Fee for outside London: £1,500 + travel and accommodation**

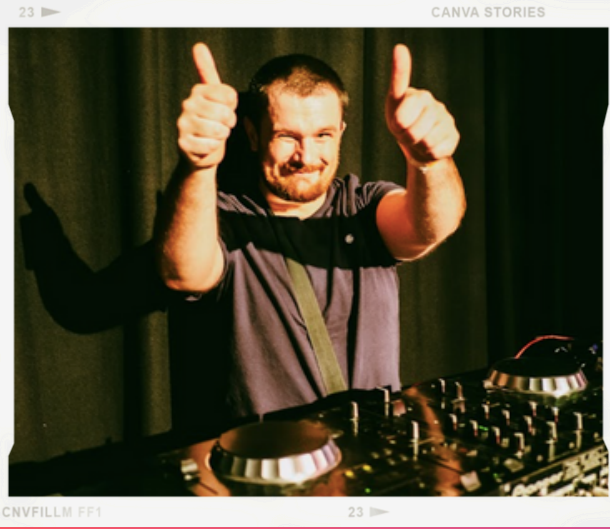


*'My voice is heard and my moves are seen here. It is the safest nightclub I have ever been to anywhere!' Attendee*
